Day 1. Jakarta. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Days 2. Jakarta. Jakarta is Indonesia's energetic capital and a fascinating mix of colonial history, massive mosques, street food, and modern skyscrapers. We will focus on a few historic landmarks, cultural sites, and great food.

Day 3-5. Tanjung Puting National Park. Fly from Jakarta to Pangkalan Bun. Our representative will meet us at the airport and take us directly to our private boats. Our private guide will explain the nature of the park. Our private chef will make an amazing array of cultural dishes. We will spend the days exploring the Tanjung Puting National Park. There will be the opportunity to see wild orangutans, gibbons, hornbills, crocodiles and many other wild animals. Nights will be spent in an Eco Lodge.

Day 6. Travel day to Ubud in Bali.

Days 7-8 Ubud

Ubud, Bali offers a rich mix of culture, nature, and adventure, making it a popular destination on the island. We can visit the Sacred Monkey Forest Sanctuary, and the Tegallalang Rice Terraces showcase Bali's famous layered rice fields and traditional irrigation system, providing beautiful views and opportunities for walking or trying the iconic Bali jungle swings. In the center of town, Ubud Palace and the Ubud Art Market allow us to experience Balinese culture through traditional architecture, nightly dance performances, and locally made crafts and souvenirs.

On the second day we can hike the scenic Campuhan Ridge Walk for peaceful views of hills and greenery and get a wonderful massage or visit nearby waterfalls such as Tegenungan, Tibumana, and Tukad Cepung.

Day 9-12. Komodo Island

We will take a 1.25 hour flight to Komodo Island from Bali. This part of the journey is a two-night on a private boat through Komodo National Park, one of the most spectacular island landscapes in Southeast Asia.

Departing from Labuan Bajo, we will board a traditional Indonesian phinisi sailing boat, which serves as both our transportation and our floating hotel. Comfortable cabins, freshly prepared meals, and spacious decks create a relaxed atmosphere as the boat cruises between dramatic volcanic islands and turquoise bays. Over three days you'll explore the park's highlights with a mix of short island hikes and snorkeling stops. A guided walk on Komodo Island offers the chance to see the famous Komodo dragons.

Day 13-15. Singapore.

We will end our adventure in style with two unforgettable days in Singapore, a city where futuristic architecture, lush gardens, and world-famous cuisine come together in one vibrant destination. Singapore offers the perfect blend of culture, food, and iconic sights. We will visit the spectacular **Marina Bay** district, with wonderful botanic gardens. Our guide will take us to Singapore's legendary hawker centers, where dozens of stalls serve some of Asia's best street food. There will be time to wander through historic **Chinatown**, where temples, traditional shophouses, and lively markets reflect the city's Chinese heritage. If time allows, we will visit vibrant **Little India**, filled with colorful temples, spice shops, and bustling restaurants.
