Thailand/ Malaysia/ Singapore Itinerary



Day 1-3. Bangkok. Stay in a hotel near Bangkok's lively Chinatown. Our wonderful native guide Bank will guide us to the classic places in Bangkok as well as hidden spots that only the locals know about.

We will work our way to the Chao Praya River, where private long-tail boat will be waiting to take you on an adventure through Bangkok's maze of canals. Unlike other tourist boats, you will head off the beaten path into some of the smaller canals and will disembark at various stops to truly experience life along the river.

We will have fun sightseeing in this diverse city, where gleaming golden temples rise beside soaring modern towers. Highlights include the dazzling Grand Palace and Wat Phra Kaew, home to the Emerald Buddha, as well as Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn. We will wander the bustling markets, of fragrant flower stalls to Chatuchak's endless maze of treasures. Hidden Speak Easy Bars, local coffee shops and small shopping venues are among the unique places we will experience.

Day 4-5. Hat Yai. Take a morning flight to Hat Yai, located in Southern Thailand. Our local guides will help us discover this not too travelled city. We will visit Namtok Ton Nga Chang National Park, a lush rainforest park known for its seven-tiered waterfall. Crystal-clear streams flow through dense jungle, and you can wade in pools which are swimming with a locally protected fish. Hat Yai is famous for its bold southern food culture — sizzling night

markets, rich curries, fresh seafood, and its legendary fried chicken.

Day 6-8. Koh Lipe

We will take private van to the west coast, and then a speed boat to Koh Lipe. Koh Lipe is famous for powdery white sand beaches. We will travel by local boat to vibrant coral reefs filled with colorful tropical fish. At night the Walking Street Market comes alive with a laid-back night food market atmosphere — fresh grilled seafood, Thai curries, fruit shakes, and beachside bars glowing under soft lights.

Day 9-10. Langkawi Island Malaysia

Travel by boat from Koh Lipe to Langkawi Island. Langkawi is a lush tropical island in Malaysia known for its soft sandy beaches, dramatic limestone cliffs, and duty-free shopping. Relax at popular beaches like Pantai Cenang, ride the cable car up to the iconic Sky Bridge for sweeping island views and explore winding mangrove forests by boat.

Day 11-13. Singapore

Singapore is a dynamic city-state where futuristic skylines meet rich multicultural heritage. Known for its striking Marina Bay skyline and the glowing Supertrees of Gardens by the Bay, the city blends cutting-edge architecture with vibrant neighborhoods like Chinatown and Little India. Singapore offers world-class dining, shopping, green spaces, and island escapes.
